This 4-hour workshop will provide a forum for participants to begin production of a written manuscript that can be submitted for publication. The morning will be composed of didactic and hands-on practice for individuals or writing cohorts. Time will be allotted for sharing ideas and suggestions as well as personal attention to individual beginning or experienced writers. The workshop will be flexible and informal to reflect the writing needs and desires of the attendees, and audience participation will be expected.

Workshop Preparation:

Attendees are asked to bring author guidelines and the journal or publication to which they want to submit a paper. Also bring one article, column, letter to the editor, or other publications to be used as a “sample” that is similar to the writing goal. Please don't forget writing materials (paper and pencil or a laptop.)

Workshop Objective

- Briefly review writing basics, ethics and legal concerns
- Analyze and discuss potential publication targets
- Compare and contrast different types of articles
- Complete an outline, title, intro and purpose of an article
- Recognize methods of submitting a paper
